- (Type O, Sat 1, Sat 1&2, Sat 1, 2, type O, type A)
- ✓ Animal movement restrictions
- ✓ Stake holders sensitization and Advocacy

- √ Vaccination of domestic animals

- ✓ Long clearing process for wildlife on borders
