

EMERGING ISSUES AT HUMAN WILDLIFE INTERFACE

- Movement of buffaloes Jun 24 to Jun 25
 - Heavy rains experienced in the KAZA landscape during period under review
 - Increased Migration of buffaloes and other wild animals into buffalo free zones
 - Aerial surveys done in KAZA landscape
- 1 goats to Namibia-Destroyed
- 27 Botswana goats, sold in Namibia 2025
- 2 cattle from Namibia repatriated, 28 currently in Botswana


B. ANIMAL HEALTH ACTIVITIES

Vaccinations

- □ FMD Vaccination
 - Chobe (3 vaccination campaigns Jun/Jul 2024, Nov/Dec 2024 and Feb/Mar 2025)
 Only cattle vaccinated
 - Ngamiland (2 vaccination campaigns Oct/Nov 2024 and May/June 2025 on-going)..
- Other diseases
 - Anthrax
 - · Quarter evil
 - · Rabies- Vaccine procurement challenges

Surveillance

- ☐ FMD (last cases recorded in 2021
- □ FMD in wildlife (viral and serology testing on-going)
- □CBPP (no recorded cases)
- □PPR (no recorded cases)
- □ Anthrax (no recorded cases)
- □ Rabies (cases of rabies were recorded)
- □EUS (no recorded cases)
